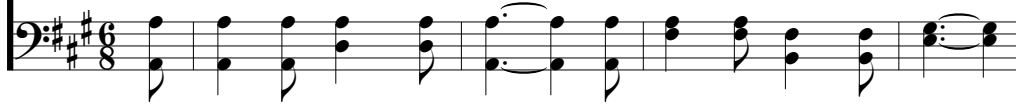


This Mediator's Mine
